






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

The horizontal axis shows GDP per capita adjusted for inflation and cross-country price differences.






The World as 100 People over the last two centuries


PERCENT DECLINES IN THE NUMBER OF DEATHS SINCE 1990*

Global death rate measured as the number of deaths per 100,000 of the world population (by decade 1900s to 2000s; and six years from 2010)


